

**WALLENPAUPACK LAKE ESTATES PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION  
RECREATION COMMITTEE MINUTES  
MAY 11, 2024**

The meeting of the WLE POA Recreation Committee was called to order by Tri Chair Lonnie Galovic at 10:03 a.m., Saturday, May 11, 2024, in the Adult Lodge. Twenty-five members stood and repeated the Pledge of Allegiance. Board liaison Scott Healy was present.

**Minutes**

Frank Carrozzolo made a motion to accept April's Treasurer's report, second by Diane Sutton. All were in favor, no opposition, Treasurer's report accepted as presented.
